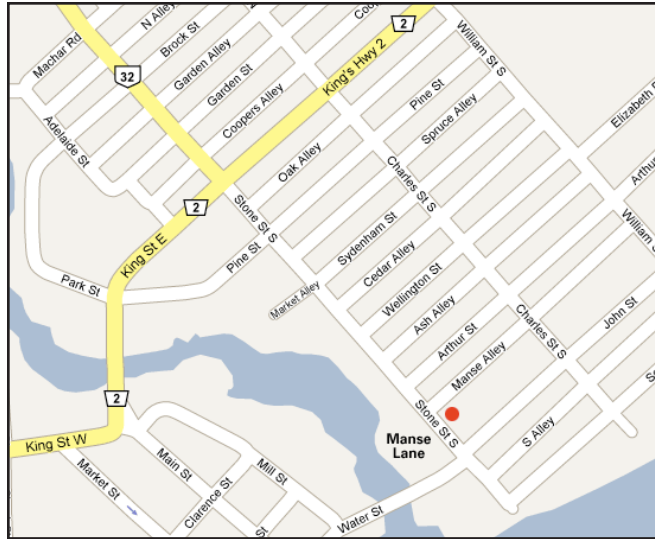

## Scheduled trains to Gananoque:

### From Toronto:

- Train 48 Departs 17:30 HRS Monday to Friday, arriving in Gananoque at 20:33 HRS.
- Train 68 Departs 18:35 HRS Monday to Friday, arriving in Gananoque at 21:36 HRS.
- Train 668 Departs 18:35 HRS each Saturday and Sunday, arriving in Gananoque at 21:36 HRS.
- Train 648 Departs 18:35 HRS each Saturday and Sunday, arriving in Gananoque at 21:43 HRS.

### From Ottawa:

- Train 45 Departs 12:35 HRS every day, arriving in Gananoque at 14:21 HRS.

### From Montreal:

There is no direct train; you can either travel to Kingston and travel to Gananoque by taxi or you can travel to Ottawa or Brockville and switch to the Gananoque train.

### From Niagara Falls:

There are two trains every day from Niagara Falls to Toronto and then you can switch to the Gananoque train at Union Station. The weekend schedule is very nice because it allows you to spend a few hours sightseeing in downtown Toronto before continuing your journey. The weekday train schedules are not as well synchronized.

### From New York City:

There are four trains daily from Penn Station in NYC to Syracuse, N.Y. (5 hours by train) and then you would need to travel from Syracuse to Gananoque by car (additional 2 hrs).

## Scheduled trains departing Gananoque:

### To Toronto:

- Train 45 Departs 14:21 HRS every day, arriving at Toronto Union Station at 17:12 HRS.

### To Ottawa:

- Train 48 Departs 20:33 HRS Monday to Friday, arriving in Ottawa at 22:15 HRS.
- Train 648 Departs 21:43 HRS each Saturday and Sunday, arriving in Ottawa at 23:38 HRS.

### To Montreal:

There is no direct train; you can either depart from Kingston or Brockville.

## By car:

We are located five minutes off Hwy 401, the main highway between Montreal and Toronto.

### From Toronto:

Take Hwy 401 east. Take exit 645 and head south on Stone Street until you reach Manse Lane (about 3 hrs).

### From Ottawa:

Option 1: Take Hwy 416 south to Hwy 401 and then take Hwy 401 to exit 648. Follow King Street until you reach Stone Street. Head south on Stone Street until you reach Manse Lane (about 2 hrs).

Option 2 (more scenic): Take Hwy 17 west from Ottawa to Hwy 7 and head to Carlton Place; take Hwy 15 South through Smiths Falls to Hwy 32; take Hwy 32 directly into Gananoque and Stone Street. Take Stone Street until you reach Manse Lane (about 2 hrs 10 mins).

### From Montreal:

Take Autoroute 20 west until it joins Hwy 401 in Ontario; take Hwy 401 to exit 648. Follow King Street until you reach Stone Street. Head south on Stone Street until you reach Manse Lane (about 2 hrs 45 mins).

### From Syracuse:

Take Interstate I-81 north from Syracuse and cross into Canada at Ivy Lea bridge; take the scenic 1000 Islands Parkway west to Gananoque. Follow King Street until you reach Stone Street. Head south on Stone Street until you reach Manse Lane (about 2 hrs).

### From Niagara Falls:

There are two options, through Canada and through the US, both take about 4 hours. If you go through the US you must cross the border twice, which could pose delays. If you go through Canada you face congestion through Greater Toronto.

Option 1 (through Canada): From Niagara Falls take the Queen Elizabeth Way around Lake Ontario to the outskirts of Toronto. If you take Hwy 427 North to Hwy 401 you might hit traffic, but you won't see the spectacular Toronto downtown. The other route is to take the QEW to the Gardiner Expressway and then head north on the Don Valley Parkway, you will get a great view of the city and the waterfront, but you almost always get traffic. The Don Valley expressway is especially nice when the fall leaves have changed colours. Take Hwy 401 east to Gananoque (about 4 hours).

Option 2 (through US): From Niagara Falls take the Rainbow Bridge to the US. Take Niagara Street to NY-384 and then to the Robert Moses State Parkway South to NY State Thruway I-190; merge onto I-290 E / Youngmann Expressway east which takes you to I-90 east to Syracuse (follow Syracuse instructions below). This trip bypasses Buffalo but the borders can be congested, especially on weekends and holidays (trip to Gananoque is about 4 hrs).

## By air:

International air travel is most easily accessed through Ottawa's International Airport (YOW), Toronto's Pearson International Airport (YYZ) or Montreal-Trudeau airport (YUL). Syracuse's Hancock International Airport (SYR) provides frequent flights throughout the US.

Kingston's Norman Rogers Airport (YGK) offers several flights daily to and from Toronto via Air Canada and Air Canada Jazz.
